sprouting and buds ready to bloom.

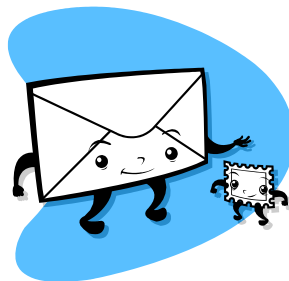

DAN'S BLURB

Happy Spring!

Now let's hope the weather starts to behave like it.

I received a lot of positive feedback from last month's Passport blurb, so I thought I would follow it up with a blurb about the Options program.

Options, like Passport, is a Federal, State and County founded program to assist seniors (those over 60) with in home services. But unlike Passport, the Options program doesn't require that an individual be eligible for Medicaid to be eligible for their program. The Options program also does not require that an individual have personal care needs as well as housekeeping needs to be eligible.

Options eligibility requirements are that an individual have a need for housekeeping services combined with a monthly income of less than \$2,500 a month and assets of less than \$25,000. Sounds like a great alterna-

tive to Passport, right?

Well there is one hitch. Options works on a sliding scale fee plan. This means that Options looks at how much money you make and charges you a small fee for their services based on that. Most individuals pay less than \$10 per hour for the service.

The other drawback compared to Passport is that when an individual is on Options they are not eligible for the side benefits that Passport provides such as Durable Medical Equipment. An individual on Options can get Transportation, Meals, Personal Care and Housekeeping services through Options.

Much like Passport, the application process is easy. An individual can come see me to fill out the referral form which would then be faxed to Options. Options would call the individual to

schedule the assessment appointment.

This program has proven very helpful for fellow residents who have income levels too high for Passport or who don't require Personal Care services needed by Passport.

If you are interested in finding out more about the program or filling out a referral form, come see me.

I will be out of the office this month from Wednesday April 6th through Monday April 11th and again on Friday April 22nd for Good Friday.

If you need assistance that can't wait for my return, please feel free to call 216-521-1515 and ask to speak to a social worker.
