gestions please see June or Eva. Popcorn & fellowship provided. :0)

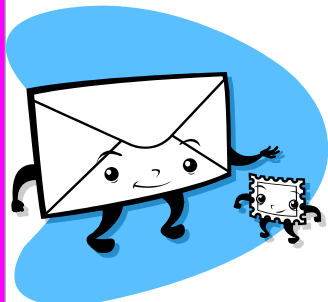
