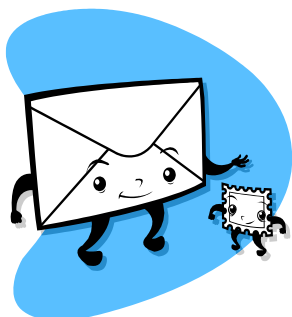
I am truly grateful for our new office volunteer—Cassie Barnes—she is a joy to work with.

Thank you Dan for the information on Medicare Part D & Low Income Subsidy (LIS). It was very well received by all.

November—one thinks of falling leaves and falling temperatures, but we should also be thinking of the upcoming open enrollment period for Medicare Part D.

Beginning Monday, November 15th, the open enrollment period allows anyone eligible for Medicare to make changes to their Part D prescription insurance for the 2011 calendar year. During this open enrollment, it is a good idea to explore what might be available to you for 2011.

Even if you are happy with your current plan, take the time to take a look at your options because you might find something cheaper. I can assist you with

this process via the computer, I just ask that you set up an appointment with me and make sure to bring your Medicare card and list of current prescriptions.

Also, with the holidays fast approaching, I want to make everyone aware that there is a Thanksgiving Day meal available to them if they don't have anywhere to go for Thanksgiving Day. Just see me to get added to the list. Deadline is Wednesday November 17th.
